GIC Medal and Prize

This prize is presented to a graduating student who is:

- The best student in NUS College awarded with a Bachelor of Business Administration (Honours) degree; and
- The best student in NUS College awarded with a School of Computing (Honours) degree.

This medal and prize is donated by the Government of Singapore Investment Corporation (GIC).

Sung Kah Kay Memorial Prize

This prize is presented to a graduating NUS College student from the School of Computing who best exemplifies academic excellence and leadership.



Syed Ahmad Khan AMU Memorial Prize

This prize is presented to two graduating students from NUS College who are well-rounded and have exemplified academic excellence and reflected a strong commitment or made a significant contribution to South Asian studies and culture. This prize is donated by the Aligarh Muslim University (AMU) Alumni Association Singapore.



Tin Chew Hong Prize

This prize is presented to a graduating student from NUS College who is well-rounded and has exemplified academic excellence and demonstrated strong commitment to community service, preferably in the areas of the elderly, ageing or gerontology. This prize is donated by Tin Pei Ling, an alumna of the University Scholars Programme.



Albert Teo Prize

This prize is presented to a graduating student from the NUS College who is well-rounded and has exemplified academic excellence and demonstrated a strong passion for entrepreneurship or innovation in the social or business sector. This prize is donated by Professor Albert Teo, a former faculty and Deputy Director (Student Life) at the University Scholars Programme.

NUSS Medal for Outstanding Achievement

This award is given to a NUS College graduating student with outstanding all-round achievements. The winner is presented with a gold medal and a NUSS membership with a one-year waiver of the monthly subscription. The winner is recognised for academic excellence, as well as significant participation in NUS student activities and/or impactful contribution in community service/voluntary work, preferably in leadership capacities.



Izzuddin Taherally Prize

This prize was established by Dr Mustafa Izzuddin, an alumnus of the University Scholars Programme and Senior Lecturer of NUS College. This prize supports a graduating student at the College, in honour of his father, Izzuddin Taherally. This prize reflects a strong commitment to promoting interfaith dialogues or activities related to social harmony.

Joanna Wong Gold Medal Award

This award is presented to the graduating student from NUS College who best embodies the ethos of the programme. The student has been evaluated for academic excellence and for commitment to co-curricular activities. Academic excellence is assessed by Grade Point Average. Co-curricular involvement is evaluated based on participation and leadership in activities that foster “learning beyond the classroom” such as the NUS College Club activities.

Anne Yeo Prize

This prize is presented to the graduating student from NUS College, who served the wider NUSC student community, demonstrated exemplary character and leadership, and served as a role model to their peers.

Yale-NUS Emerging Young Leader Award

This prize is presented to the graduating student from NUS College who has made the most tangible and sustained contributions in tackling a local or global challenge.

IEx Capstone Award (Individual Category)

This award recognises NUS College students who have demonstrated passion and commitment over and beyond the pursuit of project goals and diligence in fulfilling admin procedures and ethics compliance.

IEx Capstone Award (Group Category)

This award recognises Impact Experience groups for their success in cultivating meaningful, ethical and productive relationships with a community partner.

Yale-NUS College Class of 2017 Award

The award recognises the graduating student from NUS College who has made significant contributions to community building within the college – someone who has fostered connection, supported their peers, strengthened campus life and embodied a collaborative spirit. This award honours individuals who carry forward that spirit of engagement, leadership and care for community.

President’s Honour Roll

The President’s Honour Roll recognises excellence in intellectual and leadership qualities among students who graduate from the NUS College according to the following criteria: outstanding academic accomplishment with Honours (Highest Distinction).
